<b>Narrative</b>												

On Feb. 28, '11, at approx. 0210 hrs., I was dispatched to the intersection of Marvin C. Zanders and 17th St., in reference to an aggravated battery with a firearm. I arrived at the intersection and did not locate any shooting scene or victims. I advised dispatch the area was clear and began to check the surrounding areas for any victims and/or a shooting scene with negative results.

Dispatch advised Apopka Police Dept. were at Florida Hospital Apopka with two victims with gun shots wounds. I responded to FHA and located an Apopka Police Officer who was present with a black male, identified as Quentin L. Taylor. Taylor was bleeding from his left cheek and from the back of his head. Taylor said he was shot at 17th St. but could not provide any other information. Due to his medical condition medical staff advised Taylor would require immediate surgery. I was not able to further question him or obtain a sworn written statement.

Nico G. Stanley was also located in the emergency room. Nico said he was at 17th St. when he heard approx. one or two shots. Nico said he does not know which intersection off 17th St. the shooting incident occurred. Nico said when he heard gun shots he fell to the ground. Nico said when he was on the ground he knew he was shot on the head. Nico said he entered his vehicle, left the area, and drove to 12th St. and Clarcona Rd.

Nico said he alerted his friend Michael Simmons, to exit the residence by honking the horn. Nico said his godmother Valerie Griffin and Michael exited the residence and drove him to FHA. Nico had a small laceration behind his left ear. Nico said he does not want to press charges and signed a Declination of Intent.

Statements attached are from Apopka Police Officers Cummings and Harmon which detail a traffic stop at 7th and Central on a white Dodge Stratus (Florida Tag 150 LVF). During the traffic stop 4 individuals were detained during a narcotics search and a Smith+Wesson Hand Gun was found wrapped in a sweaty black T shirt inside a black nylon back pack. The male detained was not wearing a shirt and he was "sweaty" (Cummings description). No one in the car claimed the black nylon bag and no one had knowledge of a gun in the bag. All 4 subjects in the car admitted to being present at "Blue Jeans" when a fight broke out inside the club and outside in the parking lot and two of people (Cagun Peterson and Sean Peterson) are related to a gun shot victim who went to Florida Hospital Apopka.

The contents of the black bag were inventoried by this writer (gloved) and receipt (Property Form) given to Officer Cummings APD 1677.

The hand gun was unloaded ( original condition as found by Cummings) and 40 rounds of .357 Winchester Ammunition were inside the bag. Five rounds of 38 Auto WW rounds were inside the bag along with a black T-Shirt and white hand towel.

The black bag and contents were given to Forensics Unit 14 (via OCSO Property Form) upon their arrival at Florida Hospital Apopka.

On Feb. 28, 2011, I responded to the area of 17th. St. and Central Ave. In reference to a possible shooting, which was reported to have occurred at or near that intersection. Upon my arrival I conducted an area check but was not able to locate a victim. As I approached the intersection of 7th. St. and Central Ave. I observed a traffic stop which had been initiated by Apopka PD. As I exited my patrol car I was informed that a shooting victim was at the hospital, and that one of the parties in the vehicle stopped by Apopka was a family member. ( Ebony Stanley)

At this time I was advised by dispatch that there was a second shooting victim at Florida Hospital Apopka, and that I need to responded. Prior to leaving I was advised by Apopka PD. that a firearm had been located in the vehicle they had stopped. I asked Apopka PD to Identify all those involved, and that they may be involved in the two shooting victims which were at the hospital.

When I arrived at FHA, I observed a B/M in room 1, later identified as Quentin Taylor. Taylor had what appeared to be an entry wound from a gun shot on his left cheek, and a small knot just above his left ear. I asked this subject his name, and who was responsible for the injuries he had received. Taylor either could not, or would not answer any questions that I asked. I was later able to obtain his name from the hospital staff. While I was attempting to question Taylor, he appeared to have a seizure. Medical personal stepped in to treat the victim, and at the time of this report the victim remained unconscious.

Dr. Tran was the attending physician at FHA who was treating the victim. At the time of this report his condition was listed as critical.

Persons Investigator Cpl. Jeffrey Bogen was contacted and responded.

Forensics 14 ( Rubart 3700) was contacted and responded to FHA, and took possession of victim Taylors personal effects and clothing.

At this time the investigation was turned over to Cpl. Bogen.
